Our club encourages knowledge and enjoyment of native birds, and actively promote the protection and conservation of native birds and their habitat.

## Birdwatchers Code of Ethics

1. The welfare of birds must come first.
2. Habitat must be protected.
3. Nests, eggs and their immediate vicinity must not be disturbed.
4. Keep disturbance to birds and their habitat to a minimum.
5. When you find a rare bird, think carefully about whom you should tell.
6. Abide by the bird protection laws at all times.
7. Respect the rights of land owners.
8. Respect the rights of other people in the countryside.
9. Do not harass rare migratory birds.
10. Make your records available to the local bird recorder.
11. Be an ambassador for your own country when birdwatching in other countries.
12. Use of playback on outings is always at the discretion of the leader.
